Roads and traffic are crazy here in Guinea. We took one road: Andy drove 10km/hour for eight hours, so you can imagine how bad the road was. We saw a few accidents, Lorry's on their sides at the roadside. Andy drove 1000 km in one week. One special purpose of the trip was to visit the two towns we could be working in: Gaoual or Labe. In the middle of January we will be moving to Labe anyway to start there with our local language learning.

At the SAM Retreat we had a great time to see friends again which we had worked along side in Macenta, also to meet all the other missionaries who work across Guinea with the Swiss mission.

During the retreat we had to make a decision where we could see ourselves working in the future, we gave our feedback and input.
