Families who've already lost their homes are terrified, and their lives are in danger. Carrying their belongings, they're seeking shelter in temporary camps, schools and churches. In an already desperate conflict, the humanitarian need is growing. Clean water is hard to come by. Hospitals are overwhelmed. Banks are closed. Places that should be safe are under attack. Pray for God's peace and provision at this time.

Each Sunday we hear from God's Word. We love it when the regular congregation want to add an insight arising from that, or to share an answer to prayer. If appropriate to be included in the livestream, why not share that in the time that will usually be given after the sermon?

At Brixham Baptist Church we believe in the power of prayer.
