Brixham Food Bank in Brewery Lane does a fantastic job of ministering to the hungry and those local people and families in need. In the Front Room Café, we have a crate for any non-perishable food items which are passed on to the Food Bank to make a difference. Most weeks we take over a nearly full crate.

But there's now another "food bank" in the Front Room to discover. Pictured here, it is a "bank of food for the soul", with a wide range of books on Christian living, Christian fiction, devotional studies, some discussing particular life-stages and needs: there really is something for everyone. We can even provide free bibles or gospels for those who would like one.

This library is the inspiration and ministry of Pam and Christine from our fellowship, with books that have been donated or purchased for the library. All have been carefully vetted, marked and recorded so we know the full range of books on the shelf. A Book of the Month is also promoted (in March some devotionals by Eddie Askew). We are applying for funding to buy more books too. If you'd like a particular title, speak to Pam or Christine.

But like any food bank, it's only of value if people know about it and use it. So please have a look yourself and borrow any book that you'd like to try. Then let others know that they too can come in and use it (not just when the Café is open). We're not overly worried if some books go astray; we just want people to be spiritually fed and nurtured from this wonderful new "Food Bank"!
