PRAYER PRIORITY

As we consider faithfulness, we may be aware of those with whom communications have been broken. An argument, a misunderstanding, an incident that broke trust or broke hearts, in recent days, months or even years. It's not easy, and maybe that simply starts with us praying into God's forgiveness for our sins so that we may have guidance about what to do next.
