

## SERMON SUMMARY : 5<sup>TH</sup> APRIL

On Easter Sunday we considered “New Life”, combining the resurrection of Jesus in Matthew 28 and the conversion and baptism of the Philippian jailer and his household in Acts 16. We also witnessed the believer’s baptism of Jamie.

2000 years ago on that Sunday morning, there was an earthquake before the angel rolled the stone away setting the risen Jesus free from the tomb. He opened the way to New Life for everyone who believes in Him.

There was also an earthquake that caused the chains to fall off Paul and Silas. But this was the prelude to the Philippian jailer and his household coming to faith and being baptised, finding New Life in Jesus.

Jesus rose to set people free from their sins, and Jamie, like every other believer who is baptised, knows their sin has been washed away and they have New Life in Jesus.

The challenge we heard was for each of us to ask (like the Jailer) “What must I do to be saved?” The answer is not “try harder”, “attend church” or “think positive thoughts”. The answer, said Paul, is to “*Believe in the Lord Jesus, and [then] you will be saved*”
